- Public-Private Partnerships

Millennials will be half of the U.S. workforce within five years and 75 percent within a decade. Fellows are young up-and-coming business leaders who represent a broad array of industries and backgrounds. This fellowship uniquely highlights the impact of public policy on Arizona's job creators and creates a network of ambitious and informed young people with the energy and interest to gain a better understanding of how public policy impacts the economic landscape.
